8) City Recorder's Report

City Recorder McHaddad reviewed the report included in the packet. In addition, he attended a meeting of small cities in the region with Council President Olivares. They met an engineer from Civil West, Oregon's circuit rider firm, which can provide certain limited services to city governments for free due to funding they receive from the State.

9) Public Works Report

Public Works Director Burns reviewed the report included in the packet. Installation of 6 radio meters was delayed due to plumbing. It is recommend that the City hires plumbers to complete the installation rather than the homeowners. Director Burns can be contacted if there are leak problems following installation. Meters are read every 90 minutes.

President Olivares is excited that this project is finally complete, and she appreciates staff work to complete the project.

City Recorder McHaddad noted that remaining SB 5561 funds, as well as ARPA funds, can be used for additional expenditures on the project.

Councilor Hensley discussed equipment options to purchase a new Programmable Logic Controller (PLC).

Director Burns recalled that a contractor is sought for arborist work on trees in the park. A request was made to install a put-put disc golf course in the Parks. Linn County Parks does not install these courses; they are installed for free by Albany Disc Club. Mayor Perry confirmed that public use of a put-put disc golf course on City Parks would be covered under the City's liability insurance

Mayor Emeritus Nick Heineck addressed the Council about his desire to rehabilitate an existing well for minimal use to water his garden. Ordinance 82-08, which established the City's water system, is not understood to specifically prohibit a well from being rehabilitated for a limited purpose such as watering a garden. The City does have strict prohibitions on ensuring that water obtained from a well does not connect to the City's water system. Mayor Emeritus Heineck will rehabilitate his well for personal gardening purposes. The Council took no action.

Mr. Joe Parsons tanked City officials for their work managing municipal affairs.

Mrs. Peggy Bishop concurred, noting that the City is getting a lot done with the help of the new City Recorder. She is looking for information about the identity of a Mr. Raymond Chong who made a local neighborhood profile on the social media app "NextDoor."
